The *Perogy Supper Miracle*, an original musical created by Winnipeg composer/producer, Danny Schur, takes centre stage at the Metropolitan Entertainment Centre, 7:00PM, Sunday, November 2, 2014. Danny Schur is known for his composition and production for artists such as Chantal Kreviazuk and Doc Walker, and original musicals *Strike!* and *The Bridge*.

Danny was inspired to compose the *Perogy Supper Miracle* through his relationship with Father Mark Gnutel and Sister Janet Kozak, a Sister Servant of Mary Immaculate (SSMI) – both of whom appear in the musical. Other cast members include Oksana Stanowych (current IHMS Music Teacher), Orycia Karpa (2010 alumna), and as well, current Grade 7 student Nina Hutsulak.

Mikhas Chabluk and Johanna Chabluk (nee Washchyshyn) have taken up a great responsibility; they have chosen to be co-chair's of the Alumni Cabinet for Move the Spirit Capital Campaign. Their dedicated support of IHMS is appreciated and the school is very proud of them and their accomplishments.

Johanna and Mikhas began attending Immaculate Heart of Mary School in Kindergarten and Grade 1 respectively. Their friendship began early when Johanna's mother, Joan Washchyshyn, held the responsibility of carpooling Johanna and the Chabluk children to school. Mikhas and Johanna grew up spending their formative years at at IHMS. While Mikhas had an eye for Johanna ever since that first carpool ride to school, he could not build up the courage to do anything about it until much later.

Johanna graduated from Immaculate Heart in 2001 and Mikhas followed exactly one year later. Johanna moved on to St. Mary's Academy and Mikhas went to St. Paul's High School. They kept in close contact through various Ukrainian cultural events, and as dance partners in Rusalka Ukrainian Dance Ensemble. Johanna graduated from St. Mary's in 2005, and Mikhas graduated from St. Paul's in 2006. Their friendship continued into university where Johanna began her studies in city planning and Mikhas in pharmacy.

From the day of that first carpool, Mikhas was still building up the courage to ask Johanna on a date. In September 2007, he finally managed to pull it off. Mikhas and Johanna were attending a wedding of a close friend when Mikhas finally asked Johanna out. Much to Mikhas' joy and amazement, she agreed to "go out with him"!

All love stories, such as this, have a vital third party that allows for wonderful things to happen. Mikhas' best friend and "wingman", Andrijko Semeniuk, another alumni of Immaculate Heart of Mary School, played a vital role in setting up the marriage proposal. With great amounts of stealth and a knack for decoration, Andrijko set up Mikhas' home with flowers and candles. He then slipped away before the couple arrived. When Johanna was brought inside, the condominium looked truly amazing. Shaking like a leaf, Mikhas asked Johanna if she would marry him. The happy couple were married a year later on September 14th, 2013.

Mikhas is now a successful pharmacist and Johanna is a professional city planner. They keep in close contact with many people from the IHMS community and about six months ago, they received a phone call from the school.

The Move the Spirit Capital Campaign needed someone to chair the Alumni branch and, as Mikhas puts it, "how can you say 'no' to Rod Picklyk?" The Chabluk's immediately accepted the task and believe that this is "a good way to give back". They both agree that IHMS has formed them into who they are and that "all children deserve a similar experience". Johanna understood from the moment they accepted their new role that a Ukrainian Catholic education is important and that the bonds and friendships she's made are "a vital constant that has carried on through life".

Mikhas and Johanna are very active members in the Ukrainian community. Mikhas sings for the Hoosli Ukrainian Male Chorus, and both Johanna and Mikhas dance for Verba Ukrainian Dance Company. They believe that the Ukrainian community should rally around Immaculate Heart of Mary School and ensure that the campaign to build a new school succeeds. "A quality education is critical and having a new multi-purpose building with the ability to provide a space for cultural events is very important to the community" affirms Johanna. The new building could become "a much needed Ukrainian cultural hub that provides space for Ukrainian dance lessons, concerts, shows and social gatherings."

Mikhas and Johanna both agree that "the school has done so much for so many, now is the time that we should give back." Immaculate Heart of Mary School is proud of these two amazing alumni The school is proud to have had an influence in their professional careers, their marriage and their lives. IHMS wishes them the best of luck and is overjoyed by having them help in making the school community even stronger.



Although the Safety Patrols mission has remained the same, their apparel has evolved. The School Safety Patrol program in Manitoba has seen many changes and improvements to ensure the uniforms meet the highest possible safety standards. In the early days there was the orange safety patrol belt that draped over the right shoulder. In more recent years there was the very visible orange School Safety Patrol vests along with an orange flag. Moving into the future the patrols will fashion a florescent yellow / green vest accompanied by the recognizable orange flag.


Fund Raising Raffle
