Brian Cherwick visits IIHMS!!

Brian Cherwick will be visiting IHMS the morning of Thursday, October 5! His presentation will be a fascinating excursion through the world of Ukrainian folk music with a unique blend of entertainment and educational experience, spiced with a healthy dose of humour. The students will have an opportunity to see and hear from his extensive collection of Ukrainian instruments.

Mr. Cherwick is a multi-instrumentalist who has performed around the world showcasing his work with Ukrainian folk music. Mr. Cherwick has a doctorate degree in Ethnomusicology and Ukrainian Folklore from the University of Alberta, and further studies at the National Musical Academy of Ukraine.
