HOLODOMOR AWARENESS DAY

"Holodomor" is the name given to the genocide by famine that occurred in Ukraine from 1932 to 1933. The name Holodomor is the Ukrainian word for "plague of hunger", or "death inflicted by starvation" derived from two words, "holod" meaning starvation/famine and "moryty" meaning to inflict death. Students will be taught about this day, in their classroom, at their level. This year commemorates the 90 year since the Holodomor.
