Ukrainians celebrate the baptism of our Lord on January 6th (Gregorian Calendar). This celebration is also called the Festival of Epiphany. On Friday, January 12, beginning at 9:00 AM, IHMS will have a prayer service in the school gymnasium to bless Holy Water. Part of the prayer service will also take place outside, in front of an ice cross. All parents and families are encouraged to join us for the prayer service. Following the blessing of the water, Father Daniel (School Chaplain), accompanied by a few students, will bless each of the rooms in the school.
