In case of a planned absence, parents/guardians are asked to notify the office by emailing attendance@ihms.mb.ca. A note/email submitted to the teacher, or a phone call, are required to explain ALL ABSENCES, including any Religious Holidays. The note should give the dates of absences and should be received from the parents. In the case of a known absence longer than three days, please see Family Trip / Vacation Protocol below.

BEFORE & AFTER SCHOOL CHILD CARE PROGRAMS

- The <u>Before School Program</u> is for any student arriving at the school prior to 8:15 AM (opening at 7:15 AM). They must go to the gymnasium, using the front doors, where a supervisor will be present.
- The After School Program is for anyone staying past 3:30 PM until 6:00 PM. Families using the After School Program will use the back doors of the school between 3:45 -6:00pm. Parents will wait in the back landing until supervisors bring the child(ren) to the parents. Families that pick up their children after 6:00 PM will be charged an incrementing late fee of \$5.00 for every 10 minutes late. Example: pickup between 5:16 - 5:25PM = \$5.00, 5:26 - 5:35PM = \$10.00, etc.

The cost for each program is as follows: \$7.00 drop-in fee / child / day / program \$55.00 / month / program (1 child) \$80.00 / month / program / family



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
