TRAFFIC SAFETY AROUND THE SCHOOL

Just a reminder about traffic safety around the school:



If dropping off / picking up using the front entrance on Flora Avenue, drivers are required to park your vehicle on one of the adjacent streets and walk your child onto the school yard. Please do not double park on Flora Avenue.

*** Please be mindful, IT IS ILLEGAL TO PARK WITHIN NINE METERS OF A STOP SIGN AT ANY INTERSECTION (including FLORA AND McKENZIE in front of the school).
