# LOUIS RIEL DAY - MONDAY, FEBRUARY 17 - NO CLASSES

As the Métis leader of the Red River Resistance of 1869-70, Louis Riel was instrumental in drafting the List of Rights, which formed the basis of the Manitoba Act, which was passed by the Parliament of Canada in the spring of 1870 and brought the new province of Manitoba into Confederation.



Louis Riel was the driving force behind Manitoba becoming Canada's fifth province. His dream of a province that embraces all cultures is still shared by Manitobans today.
