

GRADE 4 STUDENTS DIVE INTO DISCOVERY WITH NATIONAL GEOGRAPHIC

Our Grade 4 students had the incredible opportunity to join a live virtual event with National Geographic Explorer Katlin Bowman Adamczyk - an oceanographer and physical scientist who studies mercury chemistry and plastic pollution. Katlin took the Grade 4 students on a virtual journey to Santorini, Greece, where she and her team are studying one of the world's most breathtaking and active volcanoes. Using a remotely operated vehicle (ROV), the team explored underwater hydrothermal vents to help scientists better understand how to predict future explosive volcanic eruptions. Students were amazed, inspired, and full of curiosity, and their reflections say it all:
