TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 30 - NO CLASSES

This day is set aside to honour those children who never returned home, and for the survivors of residential schools, as well as their families and communities. Public commemoration of this history, and the ongoing impacts of residential schools, is a vital component of the reconciliation process.

On this National Day for Truth and Reconciliation, everyone is encouraged to take time for reflection, prayer, and learning. It can be an opportunity to explore the rich and diverse cultures, voices, experiences and stories of the First Nations, Inuit, and Métis peoples. As we do this, we get to experience a small taste of what it will be like one day when every nation, tribe, and language is united in harmony.
