Please note, the School Office does not keep cash change on hand to break large bills.

Hot Dog Days are all thanks to two dedicated parent volunteers. The Parents' Guild would like to welcome Nadiia Panas to the Hot Dog Team, and our returning team member, Olha Buduykevych, as the Coordinators. Hot Dog Days are organized by the Parents' Guild, with revenues earmarked for field-trip busing. Hot Dog Order Forms are sent home with a due date to place an order with the homeroom teachers.

Exact change is appreciated. The first Order Day is Thursday, October 16. Forms will go out on Tuesday, October 14. Orders after 12:00 noon cannot be accepted. A Single Hot Dog is \$2.50 and the Full Meal Deal (Hot Dog / Chips / Drink) is \$5.00.



Pizza Lunch Days are organized by the Grade 8 class with revenues earmarked for their graduation celebration in June. Pizza is sold for \$2.50 per slice (cheese or pepperoni). Students bring their pizza money (exact change) on the Pizza Order Day. Students place the pizza order with their homeroom teacher in the morning. Pizza must be ordered by noon - late orders cannot be accepted. The pizza will arrive on the Pizza Lunch Day and be delivered to the classroom. Other food and drinks can be brought from home to supplement the pizza lunch. First Pizza Order Day will be November 4.
