

Lifetouch photo proofs were sent home on Thursday, September 25. Orders are due back on Tuesday, October 7 .Please order by this date to avoid extra costs. There are two ways to order photos:

All IHMS uniform's are official school attire and must be purchased from the IHMS Uniform Shop (135 McGregor Street). There are two ways to purchase from the IHMS Uniform Shop ... shopping in-person at the Uniform Shop, or by shopping online. Families shopping inperson at the Uniform Shop are required to make an appointment before visiting the Uniform

If you still have forms, fees or any outstanding items to submit to the School Office, please do so no later than Wednesday, October 8.



PROVINCIAL ASSESSMENTS

Every fall IHMS assesses each

Grade 3 child's reading and numeracy skills. (Numeracy skills are the ability to work with numbers in various ways and to solve math-related problems). This report is part of a province-wide assessment. It is called the GRADE 3 ASSESSMENT. The report tells parents if their child's skills in reading and numeracy are at the expected level for their grade. If the child needs assistance in reaching this level, the report can serve as the basis
