


MONDAY, NOVEMBER 3 - HIGH SCHOOL INFORMATION SESSION & PARENTS' GUILD MEETING

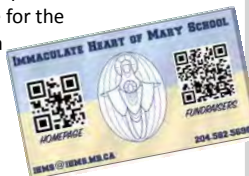
