



IHMS CHRISTMAS CONCERTS

Thursday, December 18th - Grades 4 -8 students will present *Aloha Christmas* at 1:30PM & 7:00PM.

Important information for parents:

- For costume items brought from home, please put them in a bag and label the clothes and bag with the child's name. Costume requirements for each class were emailed to families on December 11th. All costume pieces brought from home should be at school by Monday, December 15.
- For evening performances, all students must be in their classroom. Dressed in costume, no later than 6:30PM.
- The Christmas Concerts are part of the school program, and students are required to take part in the preparations and all performances. If a student is unable to perform, a note from parents was required to be provided to the homeroom teacher last week. Otherwise, students are required to attend both their afternoon and evening performances.
- On the day of the concert, the school yard will be open for parking, as well as on the adjacent streets. **Parking is not permitted in the back lane behind the school** due to a City of Winnipeg by-law. Immaculate Heart of Mary School also hires a security guard to patrol the parking areas.
- Each of the Christmas Concerts will be video recorded. Orders will be taken in January 2026. What a precious keepsake this video will be in the future!
